I cannot say enough for the help you gave us when my daughter Sandy needed her liver transplant. Your donation was such a kind gift, at a time when I had no way of knowing how we could make it.

I had to sign a contract that I would be financially responsible, but also, I lived in her hospital room, so I was unable to earn my own income.

Sandy was within days of dying. All we could do is pray and hope for a miracle. We knew if we could get a liver, which is near impossible, she had a good chance of survival. Her surgery was thirteen hours and 30 units of blood. They said she was so far gone, but they would try. They did and she made it.

That was in December 2009 and Sandy is living a near normal life. She is still not back to work, and we have had some pretty scary bumps along the way. But I will say with your support and your generous donation, help make the recovery and the long stay in Vancouver possible.

I saw a miracle and I do not know how to thank your group enough. When you are told to get your child's affairs in order, you scramble like an idiot, and then someone calls you from a group called Davey Derby and offers to help, I knew we were not only touched by the grace of God, but also miracles really do happen.
